### Description

The *Foundational Awareness of Weapons of Mass Destruction/Terrorism* course is a self-directed, online course that provides foundational awareness of weapons of mass destruction/terrorism (WMD/T) types and effects in the context of non-governmental organizations supplying humanitarian services during a disaster.
